

## A little more about Home from Home

When Home from Home was established as an NGO in 2005, its aim was to provide South Africa's orphaned, abandoned and abused children with supported and supervised community-based foster care.

## In other words – a place they could really call home.

Today, through a network of small family homes – with no more than 6 children per home, and a trained and dedicated foster mother – Home from Home currently cares for many children in need.



## Although Leila and Sizwe lived with their mum – theirs wasn't an easy childhood.

They were often left alone for long periods of time, and at only 5 years old, Leila was responsible for looking after her little brother Sizwe. Every day and night, Leila would roam the streets looking for food for her brother and herself, and only when neighbours contacted a social worker did help arrive, and the children were placed with one of our foster mothers. Today Leila's learning to be a little girl again, and both she and Sizwe are finally starting to accept love and care from adults.
